### **DUTIES OF BALLPARK MAINTENANCE EMPLOYEES**

Ballpark Maintenance Employees will work under the direction of the Field Manager and will be involved in all aspects of maintenance of the park, ensuring a positive experience for players, coaches and spectators who come through the gates on any given day. This will include preparing the two baseball fields for games, maintaining and cleaning all areas of the ballpark, along with some landscape maintenance and mowing of weeds and grasses. Employees on duty will represent Double Angel Foundation, and the spirit of Dillon and Logan Dixey for whom it is named, in all contact with people at the ballpark.

### **HOURS AND SALARY**

The work schedule for employees is determined by the field rental schedule – with play beginning annually after snowmelt (Feb or March) and ending in November as the snow begins to fly. The busiest months are June and July, although weekends are completely booked from the end of March through mid-September, and most weekday evenings have games or practices beginning early March. Varied and flexible work schedules are possible, as maintenance work is needed 7 days a week. Weekend availability is a plus. Very limited hours may be available during the off-season for regular maintenance. Salary is \$10-\$12 per hour, based on experience.

### **WORK ENVIRONMENT**

- Work is primarily performed outside in all weather conditions, and is physically demanding. The job involves physical labor and lifting of heavy objects.
- Due to the nature of the work, hours are highly sporadic, both in number of hours each week, and in the times. Workers will be scheduled in advance, but the ability to be on-call is highly desirable.
- Employees need to have a strong work ethic, as they will often be without direct supervision. They also need to have good decision-making ability and be willing to take direction.
- The Double Angel Ballpark is fast becoming one of the premier facilities in Colorado, and as such, we strive for the best field conditions possible at all times, given the resources of a non-profit organization. All Ballpark Maintenance Employees need to be willing to give the ballpark the tender loving care needed to provide a quality experience for everyone!!

### **REQUIREMENTS**

- Ability to speak and understand English
- Must have own transportation
- Must have personal cell phone
- Must be able to lift heavy objects and perform shovel and raking activities
- Problem solving skills and ability to trouble-shoot equipment malfunctions is needed
- Regular access to email required
- Proximity to the ballpark (West side of Parker) is a huge plus
